CONDITIONS FOR THE MYROSLAV SKORYK INTERNATIONAL VIOLIN COMPETITION

The International Myroslav Skoryk violin competition is founded by the outstanding musician of contemporaneity, the Hero of Ukraine, laureate of the Taras Shevchenko National Prize of Ukraine, academician Myroslav Skoryk.

The organizers of the Competition are the Ministry of Culture of Ukraine, Lviv Regional State Administration, M. Lysenko Lviv National Music Academy, Lviv Philharmonic, National Academy of Arts of Ukraine, Charitable Foundation «Support for artistic youth».

The purpose and the objectives of the Competition are honoring the prominent Ukrainian composer and musician, the Hero of Ukraine, laureate of the National Taras Shevchenko Prize of Ukraine Myroslav Skoryk, support of the most gifted violinists of the world and promotion of the academic art.

The competition will be held from December 8 to December 14, 2018 in Lviv on the base of M. Lysenko Lviv National Music Academy and Lviv Philharmonic.

I. LIST OF PARTICIPANTS

The competition is held in two groups:

Group I- participants under the age of 18;

Group II - participants under the age of 30.

II. REPERTOIRE REQUIREMENTS

The competition is held in two rounds for the first group and in three rounds for the second group, the third round is accompanied by a symphony orchestra.

All the works are performed by heart. Sonata for violin and piano, Concerto for violin with orchestra can be performed from notes.

The competition program consists of the following works:

Group I

- I round – Two contrasting polyphonic parts for Solo Violin (J. Bach);
 – One of the caprices (etudes) for Solo Violin by the participant's choice (H. Vieuxtemps, Ch. Dancla, J. Dont, P. Rode, H. Wieniawsky N. Paganini,);
 – M. Skoryk – Caprice for violin solo
- II round – One of M. Skoryk's sonatas of the violin and the piano by the participant's choice (I part or II and III parts);
 – One or several M. Skoryk's plays by the participant's choice («Poema», «Melodia», Karpatska rapsodiia», «Kazakhska rapsodiia», «Allegretto i Tanets», «Ispanskyi tanets», «Air», «Valse», «Scherzo», «Epitafiia»)*
(The total program duration up to 30 minutes)

Group II

- I round – J. Bach – Two contrasting parts or Ciaccona from Sonatas and Partitas for Solo Violin**;
 – One of the caprices for Solo Violin by the participant's choice (N. Paganini, H. Wieniawsky);
 – M. Skoryk – Caprice for violin solo
- II round – One of M. Skoryk's sonatas of the violin and the piano by the participant's choice;
 – A work of virtuoso character by the choice of the participant;
 – One of M. Skoryk's plays by the participant's choice («Melodia», Karpatska rapsodiia», «Poema», «Kazakhska rapsodiia», «Allegretto i Tanets», «Ispanskyi tanets», «Air», «Valse», «Scherzo», «Epitafiia») *;
- III round – One of M. Skoryk's concerts for violin and orchestra (№№ 1, 4, 5, 6, 7) by the participant's choice.

III. CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION IN THE COMPETITION

To participate in the Competition by November 1, 2018, the following documents must be sent to the Competition e-mail (konkurslnma@gmail.com):

- An application of the established form;
- A certificate from the place of study;
- A short creative biography (for a booklet);
- High-quality photo (electronic version: jpg, tiff, pdf format (with resolution not less than 300 dpi or a black and white photo on a matte paper measuring 13x18 cm).

The participants will receive an e-mail about receipt of the documents. In the absence of a complete set of documents or late submission of documents, candidates will not be allowed to participate in the Competition.

On the day of arrival at the Competition, each participant pays a charitable entrance fee, is for the first group –800 UAH, for the second – 1000 UAH.

All the expenses related to the participation in the Competition are at the expense of the participants or the sending side. The Organizing Committee, at the request of the participants, facilitates accommodation at their own expense.

Travel expenses, jury members' payment are carried out at the expense of the Organizing Committee of the Competition.

IV. COMPETITION ORDER

Registration, opening and drawing of the participants will take place on December 8, 2018.

The order of the performances is determined by drawing, which is kept till the end of the Competition. By the results of the second round in the first group and the third round in the second group, the jury defines the winners of the Competition.

The winners of the Competition are obliged to make a free performance in the final concert, which will be held on the occasion of the completion of the Competition.

V. PREMIUMS AND AWARDS

The winners of the Competition in each group are awarded diplomas of the I, II, III, IV, V degrees.

The Organizing Committee determines the awards and establishes the following awards for the winners of the Competition:

The total amount of the prize money is 250000 UAH.

In addition to the Laureate's title, there are two titles of the Competition the Winner and Special Prizes:

- The prize "For the best performance of M. Skoryk's work;
- Prize "For the best performance M. Skoryk's Caprice for violin solo";
- Audience choice award.

Depending on the results of the Competition, the jury is entitled to award not all the prizes, as well as to divide them among the participants.

In agreement with the jury of the Competition, sponsors have the right to set up additional awards to the participants.

The participants of the Competition who are not the winners will be awarded the certificates of the competition participant.

All the premiums are paid in the national currency of Ukraine.

The jury's decision is final and cannot be reviewed.
