

This MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING ("MOU") is made effective on the 24th day of April, 20 19.

Between:

**THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF
GRANT MACEWAN UNIVERSITY
Located in Edmonton, Alberta, Canada
("MacEwan")**

And

**Lviv National Musical Academy named after Mykola Lysenko
Located in Lviv, Ukraine
("LNMA")**

(Collectively referred to as the "Parties")

WHEREAS:

- A. MacEwan, duly incorporated pursuant to the *Post-Secondary Learning Act* of Alberta, as amended, offers bachelor's degrees, applied degrees, diploma and certificate programs to registered full-time and part-time students. MacEwan's programming mix includes English as a Second Language ("ESL") and courses designed to prepare students for entry to MacEwan's academic programs;
- B. The Institution, a duly constituted institution of higher learning, provides instruction to registered students. Within the framework of cooperation and expansion of cultural cooperation between the parties to the agreement we invite full-time students to obtain a bachelor's and a master's degree after what they will receive a diploma. The Lviv national music academy named after Mykola Lysenko according programming mix includes preparatory courses to prepare for entry to our higher educational institution. We also offer post-graduate study for students who have decided to become a Doctors of Philosophy.
- C. The Parties foresee that mutual cooperation may assist both Parties to achieve their respective strategic goals. These goals include delivering exceptional educational programming and providing enriching learning experiences to faculty, staff and students.

THEREFORE:

This MOU describes the mutual support and coordination (generally defined herein as "Activities") that each Party agrees to undertake in furtherance of their strategic goals.

IN CONSIDERATION of the Parties' mutual undertaking, the Parties agree to the following:

1. The Parties agree to establish a working relationship to consider and explore all Activities that may be of mutual benefit of the Parties. However, nothing in this MOU obligates or commits either Party to participate in any Activity.
2. In the event that the Parties agree to undertake and participate in Activities, the details and specific requirements of any Activity will be negotiated separately in good faith and the terms and conditions for such Activity shall be recorded in a separate operating agreement duly signed by both Parties.
3. For the purposes of this MOU, the Parties agree that Activities may include, without limitation, any of the following:
 - (a) study opportunities for visiting international students;
 - (b) exchange of faculty, staff and students;
 - (c) learning opportunities for teaching and administrative personnel;
 - (d) reciprocal assistance for visiting faculty and staff as required for the delivery of projects;
 - (e) joint research projects;
 - (f) joint projects that are externally funded;
 - (g) such other partnerships that are of mutual benefit to the Parties.
4. The Parties agree to treat all information exchanged pursuant to this MOU as strictly confidential. The obligation of strict confidentiality shall survive the termination or expiry of this Memorandum of Understanding.
5. This MOU shall remain effective for a period of 5 years.
6. Notwithstanding the foregoing, this MOU is subject to revision, renewal, or cancellation by mutual consent of the Parties evidenced in writing.


